<u>Free</u> after-school activities offered by the Township of Upper Moreland Parks and Recreation Department are available to all 4th & 5th grade U.M. Township Residents. This program is open to public, private, and parochial school children, and will be held in the Upper Moreland Intermediate School Gymnasium on the dates listed below. *No equipment required to participate.

Each program runs 5 weeks, from 2:50-3:50 (Please arrive at 3:45 for pick-up)

Tuesdays, 4/16, 4/30, 5/7, 5/14, 5/21 (omit 4/23) – Games & Sports

Wednesdays, 4/17, 4/24, 5/1, 5/8, 5/15 – Games & Sports

Thursdays, 4/18, 4/25, 5/2, 5/9, 5/16 – Games & Sports

*Participants may sign up for one session only.

Program Notes:

- 1. All participants must be picked up by 3:50. <u>Any child who is picked up more than 5 minutes late will be removed from the program upon the second occurrence</u>. Transportation is not provided by the district or township. Only UMIS-designated "Walkers" are permitted to walk home.
- **2**. While friendly competition is encouraged, **sportsmanship**, **respectful behavior**, and **cooperation** are of greater importance. Participants who present consistent and/or significant behavioral issues will be excused from a session or the remainder of the program.
- 3. Due to the large number of participants and the importance of creating a finalized roster for district personnel, <u>sign</u> <u>-ups must occur by the established due date</u>. In addition, <u>the maximum number of participants for each day</u> is 30 students...this number may vary based on instructor availability.
- **4**. If school is closed or dismissed early due to inclement weather, the intramural class for that day is cancelled and will only be made up if time and space permit.
- **5**. Upon entering the gymnasium after school, participants are to be seated in designated areas as the attendance process occurs. Those who do not appear on the daily roster will be directed to their normal dismissal location.
